With modular twist-on antenna options, GPS sync support, and up to 3 Gbps of unlicensed throughput across the 5 GHz and 6 GHz\* bands, the B6x offers enhanced flexibility, higher capacity, and broader deployment potential. It is the ideal upgrade from the Product for networks seeking fiber-like speeds in a scalable, easy-to-deploy solution.

\*6 GHz support is pending regulatory approval in the U.S. and will become available upon completion of FCC/AFC certification.
